JERSEY CITY POLICE ‘GET SMART’ Unveil Pilot Program of Green Vehicles

JERSEY CITY – Mayor Jerramiah T. Healy and representatives of the police department will unveil their first vehicle in a pilot “Smart Car” program during 11:30 am ceremonies, Friday, December 5, 2008, at the OEM Headquarters, 715 Summit Avenue.

The unveiling will be the first of its kind for the 154-year-old Jersey City police department, which hopes that the new vehicle will live up to its billing of saving the municipality 40 percent in fuel used for similar vehicles already in the fleet.

“During these difficult economic times, this vehicle comes at the right time. Not only is it more affordable, it is eco-friendly as well. Now that’s a smart car,” Healy said.

A demonstration will follow the unveiling.
